Dear Chair Harimoto and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for this opportunity to submit testimony in support of SB 2036, Authorizing the Issuance of General Obligation Bonds and Making an Appropriation for the Purchase of East Kaua'i Workforce Affordable Housing. My testimony is submitted in my individual capacity as a member of the Kaua'i County Council and as Chair of the Kaua'i County Council Housing & Transportation Committee.

This measure is included in the 2016 Kaua'i County Council Legislative Package, meaning that a majority of the County Council voted for it. I wholeheartedly support this measure as it would greatly assist Kaua'i County in addressing the critical and ever-growing need for affordable housing for residents.

Courtyards at Waipouli (Courtyards) was built to satisfy a zoning condition. Eighty-two (82) workforce housing affordable to qualified families were required but only for ten years. The affordability requirement of the Courtyards at Waipouli expires in 2019, allowing the units to be sold and/or rented at market rates, and thereby decreasing the number of affordable housing units available on the Eastside and on Kaua'i. Tenants will be effectively evicted when market rents are required of those who are living there now. The County of Kaua'i has the first right of refusal to purchase the workforce housing units. Authorizing the issuance of General Obligation Bonds and appropriating moneys for the purchase of properties on the east side of Kaua'i will enable the County to purchase the Courtyards project and keep those units affordable in perpetuity for generations of local qualified families.
