**DEPARTMENT'S POSITION**: The Department of Human Services (DHS) supports this proposed bill provided that its passage does not replace or adversely impact priorities indicated in the Executive Budget.

**<u>PURPOSE</u>**: The purpose of the bill is to appropriate \$55,000 to expand the emergency rent and utility assistance program within the DHS Homeless Programs Office.

Currently the DHS administers a program called the State Homeless Emergency Grant (SHEG) program that is geared toward meeting emergency rent, utility and other financial needs to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless. Historically SHEG has been funded at \$500,000 statewide. In October 2015 the Governor's Emergency Proclamation added \$300,000 more to two contracts for this service to assist additional individuals and families.
