This bill clarifies the Chief Information Officer's (CIO) authority to transfer and expend funds on technology projects, which were identified in the last executive budget, Act 119, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015 (Act 119).

The Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) was appropriated funds in Act 119 to conduct a feasibility study to modernize its child support enforcement system. We support this bill as it clarifies the CIO's authority to transfer the appropriated funds to the designated agencies.
