SUBJECT: SB 2558 – RELATING TO AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE HOMELESS

POSITION: The Governor's Coordinator on Homelessness appreciates the intent of this measure, as it supports key aspects of the state's efforts to address homelessness. However, the Coordinator's support of this measure is limited to the extent that passage of this bill does not replace or adversely impact priorities indicated in the Executive Budget. The Coordinator defers to the Department of Human Services (DHS) with regards to issues relating to the administration of homeless programs, including shelter. While the Coordinator establishes and coordinates State policy to address homelessness, the DHS Homeless Programs Office (HPO) is responsible for the administration and implementation of homeless programs.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the bill is to appropriate \$5 million in general funds for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the cost of developing emergency and transitional shelters and non-recurring costs of other homeless projects and programs. The bill would also reduce the general fund appropriation under Act 202, Session Laws of Hawaii of 2015, to the emergency and budget reserved fund by \$5 million, and would require DHS to submit reports based on the expenditures of the appropriation.
