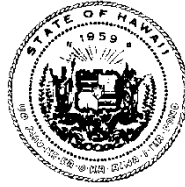

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

Honorable Chair Hashem and Members of the House Committee on Housing, thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony regarding Senate Bill (SB) 2565, relating to the Hawaii Public Housing Authority.

The Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA) supports this measure to repeal the State Housing Sales Program of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority (HPHA). The HPHA agrees with the Legislature that State public housing units should not be sold to its tenants but should remain under the HPHA's ownership for rental to low-income tenants, which is a major immediate public need in Hawaii today. For at least the last ten years, the HPHA has not utilized the State Sales Housing Program, and has no plans to use it in the future. It is understood that this measure will not affect any private-public partnerships.

The HPHA appreciates the opportunity to provide the House Committee on Housing with the HPHA's comments regarding SB 2565. We thank you very much for your dedicated support.
