Subject: SB 2579, molokai subsistence fishing hearing February 17, 2016, Capitol

Chair Gabbard , Senators Water, land , agriculture committee

We urge the adoption and rapid implementation of SB 2579, community based Subsistence fishing on the north coast of Molokai from Kalaupapa to Halawa. By the mandates of our Hawaii constitution, the Molokai subsistence task force report dated 1994, and the state statute 1996 directing that there be community-based subsistence fishing areas, SB 2579 is a quarter century overdue. Is that by intent or gross negligence or simply not caring enough?

I fear that our Kamaaina Hawaiian-based culture is at a crossroads today. Tomorrow it may be extinguished or it may be flourishing depending on your actions. Is there any wonder why there are TMT protests, issues of federal status or

a Hawaiian nation, why the indigenous people of native Americans have fishing rights while Hawaiians do not.

Molokai Subsistence fishing has been studied for over a quarter century. The term "subsistence" in the 1996 state statute comes from The Governors task force on Molokai subsistence report; it is over 100 pages long by DBEDT, the Molokai community, the University of Hawaii and consultants. The Report recommended in 1994 community-based subsistence fishing at Moomomi beach through DLNR Rules and Mac Poepoe is still waiting today 22 years after he cochaired the governors task force on Molokai subsistence fishing.

I suggest that it is the legislature's responsibility to designate the community-based subsistence fishing areas. Once designated by statute, as SB 2579, then the rules through DLNR should be developed with uniformity.

Some fishermen, non-subsistence, and largely from Oahu and Maui, may object; so be it. It is the governments' duty to decide legislatively among contending parties. The concept of Konohiki fishing rights applies to Molokai. Makai watch will be from Kalaupapa and Halawa residents and from the Pelekunu Home of Joyce Kainoa.

Your adoption of SB 2579 will provide faith , hope and love. Faith that our government system works. Hope that our Kamaaina Molokai Hawaiian culture will flourish,. And love, that we are all people of Aloha, supporting The Friendly Isle 's subsistence.

Please pass SB 2579; it is 22 years overdue Since the 1994 final report of the Molokai subsistence task force created by the governor.
