- SB 2478--Establishes a long-term care surcharge on state tax (.5%) to pay for claims for defined benefits under the long-term care financing program.

Both bills draw attention to programs that need are in need of support. The question is whether increasing the G.E.T. is the appropriate means to fund additional government programs.

We oppose this measure. While the intent of the bill is to enhance social benefits, there is a problem because it will also place an economic burden on Hawaii businesses and residents. Please keep in mind that profit margins are already quite sparse for grocers, which generally operate at a profit margin of around one percent. Increasing the GET, even by one percent, would be detrimental to the state, in particular small or rural island communities that are **less** able to absorb the additional cost.

Hawaii residents already pay very high prices for food and drinks. We are one of only a handful of states that pay taxes on groceries and our food costs can be up to seventy percent more than the national average.
