808 Cleanups supports SB2620. Through our cleanups across the islands, we are aware of the damages that can occur with increased access to these man-made hazards and non-improved areas. However, we believe that all people should have access to these areas because the vast majority of outdoor enthusiasts are responsible users. If SB2620 fails to pass, the man-made hazards and non-improved areas in question will continue to be closed off to the public due to a handful of bad apples spreading bad practices. Outdoor recreation users need to take responsibility for their actions and hold themselves and not the state accountable for when accidents happen. We want to work with the State, City and County, and other organizations to makes these spaces cleaner, safer, and more beautiful for locals and tourists to enjoy.
