### RELATING TO THE PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL SPACE CENTER FOR EXPLORATION SYSTEMS (PISCES).

Chair Nishihara, Vice Chair Espero, and members of the Committee.

The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism <u>supports</u> this bill to amend Section 201-77 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes to reduce the number of Aerospace Advisory Committee members appointed by the Governor from ten to nine.

This measure will eliminate the ex-officio non-voting NASA representative from the Committee, which historically has not participated in PISCES Board meetings and made it difficult to achieve a meeting quorum.
