RELATING TO DISPOSITION OF EXCESS REVENUES

Senate Bill No. 2844, S.D. 2, authorizes \$1 million in general fund revenues to be deposited into the Emergency and Budget Reserve Fund (EBRF). The measure is being proposed to remedy the 2015 Legislature's intended means to comply with the constitutional mandate to provide a tax refund or credit or make a deposit into a reserve fund. The 2015 Legislature authorized a \$10 million general fund appropriation to be deposited to the EBRF; however, it was not effectuated due to a processing error. Senate Bill No. 2844, S.D. 2, reduces the general fund appropriation to be deposited into the EBRF from \$10 million to \$1 million with the intention of redirecting \$9 million to fund homeless facilities and public housing projects.

The Department of Budget and Finance supports the intent of this measure.
