Re: Support for SB 2864, Relating to Physician Discipline

My name is Dr. Leslie Chun, and I am the Vice President of Medical Staff Services and Chief Quality Officer at The Queen's Health Systems (Queen's). I would like to express my support for SB 2864, Relating to Physician Discipline. This bill authorizes the Hawaii Medical Board (Board) to impose the same disciplinary action against a licensee as was taken by another state or federal agency.

At Queen's, we take patient safety very seriously. This bill will help to protect the safety of patients in Hawaii by creating a new mechanism by which the Board can discipline physicians who were disciplined by another state or federal agency. During the disciplinary process, the physician will not be allowed to practice in Hawaii and patients will not be at risk of receiving medical treatment from a physician who was seriously disciplined elsewhere.
