Thank you for the opportunity to testify in **support** of this important measure. The purpose of this measure is to require new building construction to include equipment that allows for the collection and use of gray water for irrigation, when practical.

I support this measure for the following reasons:

- 1. Gray water, or greywater, is recycled water from bathroom sinks, showers, bathtubs, and washing machines. With proper equipment, gray water is successfully used for irrigation, saving potable water for human consumption. As Chair of the Maui County Council's Water Resources Committee, I believe this properly promotes water conservation. Conservation of ALL available water is the most effective way to ensure adequate source and reduce the need for wastewater treatment and use.
- 2. Enactment of this measure would make a strong policy statement that the State of Hawaii supports increased gray water use. By providing an exemption where gray water equipment is impractical, this measure ensures developers of affordable housing and small residential projects are not unduly burdened.
- 3. Gray water equipment is increasingly simple and affordable to install, as seen at greywateraction.org, the website for "Greywater Action for a Sustainable Water Culture." The long-term savings in water costs will exceed installation costs in most cases.
