### **RE: S.B. 424; RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE HONOLULU FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER.**

Chair Espero, Chair Keith-Agaran, Vice Chair Baker, Vice-Chair Shimabukuro, members of the Senate Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental and Military Affairs, and members of the Senate Committee on Judiciary, the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney of the City and County of Honolulu ("Department") submits the following testimony in <u>strong support</u> of S.B. 424. This is one of only two bills in the Department's 2015 Legislative Package.

The Department is requesting \$350,000 as a grant-in-aid for the Honolulu Family Justice Center. This public safety initiative will provide comprehensive services for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking, as well as long term transitional housing.

The Honolulu Family Justice Center will provide victims with a safe environment during some of their most vulnerable stages of separation from their abuser, and encourage increased trust and understanding between victims, police and prosecutors, to better facilitate and followthrough on prosecution of these offenses. This, in turn, will help to hold more offenders accountable for their actions, and ultimately decrease incidents of recidivism.

For all of the foregoing reasons, the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney of the City and County of Honolulu <u>strongly supports</u> the passage of S.B. 424. Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this matter.

In the past, we have supported prior efforts to pass similar legislation for the Honolulu Family Justice Center. We reiterate our strong support for the underlying intent and purpose of this Bill.

There clearly is a need for an "one stop shop" to address ongoing situations of domestic violence, sexual abuse and related trauma that currently does not exist. Ala Kuola has already committed to the completion and filing of Family Court TROs for the Honolulu Family Justice Center. The Honolulu Family Justice Center is intended to provide a facility that provides comprehensive services to address all aspects of domestic violence at a single location, which has been lacking up to this point in time.
