<u>TESTIMONY ON SENATE BILL 528 MAKING A MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE</u> <u>HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION</u>

My name is Dayton M. Nakanelua and I am the State Director of the United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO (UPW). The UPW is the exclusive bargaining representative for approximately 12,000 public employees, which include blue collar, nonsupervisory employees in Bargaining Unit 01 and institutional, health and correctional employees in Bargaining Unit 10, in the State of Hawaii and various counties. The UPW also represents about 1,500 members of the private sector.

The UPW supports SB528 that authorizes the State Auditor to conduct a management audit of the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation.
