## **Department's Position:**

The Department of Education would like to provide comments of concern related to SB836, SD1. The intent of the measure is to provide a process to more readily identify needed facility space for charter and preschools. However, we are concerned that the process places DOE in a role of managing facilities beyond its expertise and purview. The measure appears to propose to bypass the oversight and management of state buildings and land that are more appropriately overseen by the Department of Accounting and General Services and the Department of Land and Natural Resources.

As such, the Department of Education cannot support this measure.
