A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 187, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, is
- 2 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 3. The University of Hawaii John A. Burns school
- 4 of medicine and the University of Hawaii at Manoa school of
- 5 nursing and dental hygiene shall implement the Hawaii health
- 6 corps program no later than June 30, 2013.
- 7 [The deans of the University of Hawaii John A. Burns school
- 8 of medicine and the University of Hawaii at Manoa school of
- 9 nursing and dental hygiene shall report to the legislature on
- 10 the status of the Hawaii health corps program no later than
- 11 twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session of
- 12 the legislature, beginning with the regular session of 2013.] "
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 304A-1144, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 repealed.
- 15 ["[\$304A-1144] Annual report. The office of the vice
- 16 president for community colleges shall prepare an annual report
- 17 to the legislature on the status of the program. This annual

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1	report shall include data on the development of the construction		
2	academy curriculum and content, teaching standards throughout		
3	the system, and overall achievement. The annual report shall be		
4	submitted no later than twenty days prior to the convening of		
5	each regular legislative session."]		
6	SECTION 3. Section 304A-3305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
7	repealed.		
8	["[\$304A-3305] Annual report. The University of Hawaii		
9	shall publish a report by September 1, 2006, and every year		
10	thereafte:	r. The report shall include information regarding the	
11	operation	of the program, including:	
12	(1)	The total number of students receiving nursing	
13		scholarship grants;	
14	(2)	The total amount of scholarship grants awarded;	
15	(3)	The number of full-time and part-time graduate	
16		students receiving scholarship grants, reported	
17		according to institution of enrollment;	
18	(4)	The amount of scholarship grants awarded to graduate	
19		students, reported according to institution of	
20		enrollment; and	

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1	(5) The total number of graduate students who withdraw		
2	from the program.		
3	(b) The annual report shall be submitted to the governor		
4	and the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the		
5	convening of each-regular session."]		
6	SECTION 4. Section 4 of Act 281, Session Laws of Hawaii		
7	2007, is repealed.		
8	["SECTION 4. The Hawaii P-20 initiative council shall		
9	prepare progress reports for the legislature no later than the		
10	last day of each calendar year for which it is funded by this		
11	and future Acts."]		
12	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
13	and stricken.		
14	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
