- 17 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
- 18 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2018, and June
- 19 30, 2019, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
- 20 those dates.
- 21 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
