# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

## PART I

SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2017-2019 all collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated with the exclusive bargaining representative of collective bargaining unit (5):

12 SECTION 9. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided  
13 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is  
14 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds  
15 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,  
16 from the respective funds.

17 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
18 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2018, and June  
19 30, 2019, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of  
20 those dates.

21 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.


