## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FAILURE TO FILE A REPORT WITH THE CAMPAIGN SPENDING COMMISSION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-340, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 3 "(f) The commission shall publish on its website the names
- of all candidate and noncandidate committees that have failed 4
- 5 to:
- 6 (1) File a report; or
- 7 (2) Correct a report within [the time allowed by] two
- 8 weeks from the notice to correct provided by the
- 9 commission."
- 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
