A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-340, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 "(C) Subsection (b) notwithstanding, if a candidate 4 committee does not file the second preliminary primary report or 5 the preliminary general report, or if a noncandidate committee 6 does not file the preliminary primary report or the second 7 preliminary general report by the due date, the fine, if 8 assessed, shall not exceed \$300 per day; provided that [+], in 9 aggregate: 10 (1) [In aggregate, the] The fine shall not exceed twenty-11 five per cent of the total amount of contributions or 12 expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period **13** covered by the report; and 14 The minimum fine, if assessed, shall be \$300." (2) 15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
