A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 . MARK LICENSING AGREEMENT PROGRAM
- 5 §302A-A Definitions. As used in this part, "mark" means
- 6 any trademark or service mark entitled to registration under
- 7 chapter 482, whether registered or not.
- 8 §302A-B Mark licensing agreement program; established.
- 9 There is established within the department a mark licensing
- 10 agreement program to allow the department and a department
- 11 school to license, as applicable, the department's or department
- 12 school's marks.
- 13 The department may enter into licensing agreements
- 14 pursuant to this part and any rules adopted pursuant to section
- 15 302A-E.
- 16 §302A-C Commercial enterprises. Notwithstanding any law
- **17** to the contrary, the department may engage in commercial
- 18 enterprises that are related and incidental to the primary

- 5 SECTION 2. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 6 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 7 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 8 the new sections in this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- **10** matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- begun, before the effective date of this Act. 11
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
