Dear President Kouchi, Speaker Saiki, and Members of the Legislature:

Re: HB523 SD1 CD1

HB523 SD1 CD1, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO RECYCLING" will become law without my signature, pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the State Constitution.

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS) to establish a recycling pilot program for the onsite collection of recyclable materials at DAGS buildings and facilities.

There is concern that there is not a sufficient amount of recyclable material in the waste stream to warrant spending for this type of program. Many of the DAGS facilities have already implemented recycling programs in which individuals or janitors volunteer to handle the recyclables.

However, the State Capitol receives an influx in public traffic during session and recyclable material could increase in the waste stream. DAGS can work with the State Capitol Management Committee to address this issue.

There is concern that DAGS received no positions and will be required to hire vendors to implement the program. The administration is committed to working with the legislature on this issue and implementing recycling programs where necessary.

For the foregoing reasons, HB523 SD1 CD1 will become law as Act 217, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, effective July 12, 2017, without my signature.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECYCLING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of accounting and general
- 2 services may establish a recycling pilot program to reasonably
- 3 provide and maintain onsite methods at buildings and facilities
- 4 managed, maintained, or serviced by the department of accounting
- 5 and general services for the collection of recyclable materials,
- 6 including paper, plastics, and deposit beverage containers, as
- 7 that term is defined in section 342G-101, Hawaii Revised
- 8 Statutes; provided that receptacles for the collection of
- 9 recyclable materials shall be located in proximity to
- 10 receptacles for solid waste disposal.
- 11 (b) The department of accounting and general services
- 12 shall submit a report to the legislature regarding the
- 13 implementation of the recycling pilot program established by
- 14 this Act, including any proposed legislation, no later than
- 15 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- **16** 2018.
- 17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much

- 1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for the
- 2 implementation of the recycling pilot program established by
- 3 this Act.
- 4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 5 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
