An arbitration award was issued for the Hawaii Firefighters Association (HFFA) concerning Collective Bargaining Unit 11 (Firefighters) on April 17, 2017. In accordance with Section 89-10(b), cost items must be submitted to the Legislature. Because this award was not issued in time for costs to be included in the biennium budget, an Administration Proposal was submitted to the 2017 Legislature. The estimated costs are as follows:
