### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 91-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending the definitions of "persons" and "party" to
read as follows:
"(2) "Persons" includes individuals, partnerships,
corporations, associations, agencies, or public or
private organizations [of any character other than
agencies].
(3) "Party" means each person [ <del>or agency</del> ] named or
admitted as a party, or properly seeking and entitled
as of right to be admitted as a party, in any court or
agency proceeding."
SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.
SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
