RELATING TO ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to update and
2	clarify the pertinent statute relating to electronic funds
3	transfers in the state treasury bank accounts.
4	SECTION 2. Section 40-51.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"§40-51.5 Checks or electronic funds transfers in lieu of
7	warrants. With reference to warrants addressed under this part
8	the comptroller may, with the approval of the director of
9	finance, issue checks drawn from, or make electronic funds
10	transfers from, depositories of state treasury moneys in lieu or
11	warrants drawn from the state treasury. Electronic funds
12	transfers include Automated Clearing House transactions that
13	debit the State's bank account under certain situations as may
14	be authorized by the director of finance."
15	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

DEPARTMENT:

TITLE:

PURPOSE:

To update and clarify section in the statues relating to electronic payments made to the

State.

MEANS:

Amend section 40-51.5, Hawaii Revised

Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION:

Amend section 40-51.5, "Checks or electronic funds transfers in lieu of warrants", to clarify that specific organizations in certain situations may be allowed to initiate ACH (Automated Clearing House) debits to the State's bank accounts.

Impact on the public: No direct impact. Indirectly will benefit government operations by clarifying sections.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Increases efficiency of operations by clarifying section relating to electronic funds collections, as agencies increasingly utilize updated methods of deposits into the bank.
