### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) There is established in the state treasury the
emergency and budget reserve fund which shall be a special fund
administered by the director of finance, into which shall be
deposited:

- (1) [Twenty-four and one half per cent of the moneys

  received from the tobacco settlement moneys under

  section 328L-2(b)(1);] Moneys received from the tobacco

  settlement moneys under section 328L-2;
- (2) Appropriations made by the legislature to the fund; and
- (3) Five per cent of the state general fund balance at the close of the fiscal year, whenever state general fund revenues for each of two successive fiscal years exceeds revenues for each of the preceding fiscal years by five per cent, pursuant to article VII, section 6 of the Hawaii constitution. ### JUSTIFICATION SHEET

TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY

AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

PURPOSE:

To remove the specific percentage of tobacco settlement moneys that is to be deposited to the Emergency and Budget Reserve Fund.

MEANS:

Amend section 328L-3(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION:

Act 118, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, codified as section 328L-2, HRS, amended the share of tobacco settlement moneys to be deposited to the Emergency and Budget Reserve Fund (EBRF) from 24.5 percent to 15 percent effective July 1, 2015. However, Act 118 did not revise section 328L-3, HRS, which also states that 24.5 percent of tobacco settlement moneys are to be deposited to the EBRF. Therefore, sections 328L-2 and 328L-3 currently reflect different percentages of the tobacco settlement moneys that should be deposited to the EBRF.

This bill amends section 328L-3 to provide that moneys from the tobacco settlement may be deposited to the EBRF. The amendment would better prevent future discrepancies and inadvertent errors.

Impact on the public: This bill would remedy the current conflicting percentages of tobacco settlement moneys to be deposited to the EBRF.

Impact on the department and other agencies: This bill would provide clarity and consistency with regard to the percentage of tobacco settlement moneys to be deposited to the EBRF. Page 2
