A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE LIBRARIAN'S SALARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Existing law authorizes the board of education
- 2 to set the salary of the state librarian as long as the salary
- 3 does not exceed a specific amount--also referred to as a salary
- 4 cap.
- 5 It has been and continues to be a challenge to recruit for
- 6 and fill this position in state leadership, because the
- 7 statutory salary cap does not align with national salary norms
- 8 and is therefore not competitive with or even in the range of
- 9 the salaries of similar leadership positions at comparable
- 10 library systems.
- 11 The statute governing the state librarian's salary has not
- 12 been amended since 2001, and the salary cap should be revised as
- 13 a matter of equity to account for cost-of-living increases.
- 14 This Act amends the current salary cap for the state librarian
- 15 based on a national review of the salaries of library directors
- 16 who oversee library systems that have comparable budgets and
- 17 numbers of employees and serve populations of similar size.

- 1 This national review of salaries of similar positions in other
- 2 states supports the change to a higher salary cap. In Hawaii,
- 3 the state librarian is responsible for a statewide district,
- 4 whereas library directors in most other parts of the nation are
- 5 responsible for the library system of only a city or county.
- 6 The amendment to the salary cap will also provide the board
- 7 of education with more discretion in hiring and retaining the
- 8 top librarian for Hawaii's public libraries.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide the board of
- 10 education, as the appointing body of the state librarian, with
- 11 more flexibility to establish the salary of the state librarian
- 12 by adjusting the salary cap for the state librarian position.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 312-2.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 15 "(b) The salary of the state librarian shall be set by the
- 16 board of education [at a rate no greater than \$120,000 a year.];
- 17 provided that the salary of the state librarian shall not exceed
- 18 the salary of the superintendent."
- 19 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.
