BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

7	authorized by chapter 89C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for			
8	legislative officers and employees excluded from collective

- 10 SECTION 4. Funds appropriated by this Act that are not
- 11 expended or encumbered by the end of the fiscal year for which
- 12 the appropriation is made shall lapse as of those dates.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
