

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 132D-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:	
3	"§13	2D-20 Enforcement[-]; probable cause for arrest. (a)
4	This chap	ter shall be enforced by each county. The counties are
5	authorized to enforce and administer the provisions of this	
6	chapter.	
7	(b) Arrests for offenses under this chapter or under a	
8	county ordinance described in section 132D-17.5 shall be made in	
9	compliance with chapter 803. Probable cause for the arrests may	
10	be established based on:	
11	(1)	Statements from individuals who witnessed the
12		offenses, even if those individuals are not law
13		enforcement officers; and
14	(2)	Photographs, video recordings, or other recordings
15		that show the commission of offenses and can be
16		authenticated by one or more witnesses."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
