### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that the
- 2 State complies with federal guidelines and reduces liability on
- 3 its roadways by requiring training and certification for
- 4 flaggers who direct traffic.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by adding a new section to part X be appropriately
- 7 designated and to read as follows:
- 8 "§286- Flagger training and certification. (a) No
- 9 person shall provide temporary traffic control in a street,
- 10 road, or highway unless the person completes training and is
- 11 certified by a program that meets the training and certification
- 12 standards of the National Safety Council highway flagger
- 13 training program, the American Traffic Safety Services
- 14 Association flagger program, or an equivalent program that meets
- 15 the same objectives. A program shall not be deemed to be an
- 16 equivalent program unless it meets the United States Department
- 17 of Transportation Federal Highway Administration standards for

- 2 the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for streets and
- 3 highways.
- 4 (b) No person may continue to provide temporary traffic
- 5 control in a street, road, or highway unless the person
- 6 undergoes training and certification requirements at least once
- 7 every four years.
- 8 (c) This section shall not apply to law enforcement
- 9 personnel who are employed by governmental entities.
- 10 (d) This section shall apply to any street, road, or
- 11 highway, regardless of the ownership of the street, road, or
- 12 highway."
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
