A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 346-156, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$346-156 Penalty. Any person violating any provision of
- 4 this [chapter] part or any rule made pursuant thereto shall be
- 5 guilty of a class C felony and shall be fined as follows:
- 6 (1) Up to [\$1,000] \$6,000 for the first violation; and
- 7 (2) Up to [\$3,000] \$8,000 for the second violation and
- 8 each succeeding violation."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2075.
