
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL SPENDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§302A- Spending; reporting requirements. (a)
5 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, at least twenty days
6 before the convening of each regular session, the department of
7 education shall report to the legislature the amount of moneys
8 that it spent during the previous school year for standardized
9 testing, test-preparation programs and activities, pre-packaged
10 lessons, and related consulting services.

11 (b) As used in this section, "pre-packaged lesson" means
12 educational course content developed by and purchased from a
13 private, for-profit entity."

14 SECTION 2. Chapter 302D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
16 and to read as follows:

1 "§302D- Spending; reporting requirements. (a)
 2 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, at least twenty days
 3 before the convening of each regular session, the commission
 4 shall report to the legislature the amount of moneys that
 5 charter schools spent during the previous school year for
 6 standardized testing, test-preparation programs and activities,
 7 pre-packaged lessons, and related consulting services.

8 (b) As used in this section, "pre-packaged lesson" means
 9 educational course content developed by and purchased from a
 10 private, for-profit entity."

11 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
