

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE RECYCLING FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 339D-10, Hawaii 'Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+]\$339D-10[+] Electronic device recycling fund. 4 There is established in the state treasury the electronic device 5 recycling fund into which shall be deposited all fees, payments, 6 and penalties collected by the department pursuant to this 7 chapter. 8 The electronic device recycling fund shall be 9 administered by the department of health. Moneys in the fund 10 shall be expended by the director [solely] for the purpose of 11 implementing [and enforcing] this chapter [-], including: 12 Reimbursement for collection services associated with (1) 13 the handling and collecting of electronic devices for 14 recycling; 15 (2) Funding administrative, audit, and compliance 16 activities associated with collection and payment of

1		all fees, payments, and penalties imposed by the
2		department pursuant to this chapter;
3	(3)	Conducting electronic recycling education and
4		demonstration projects; and
5	(4)	Supporting the handling and transportation of the
6		electronic devices collected to end-markets.
7	(c)	Any funds that accumulate in the electronic device
8	recycling	fund shall be retained in the fund unless determined
9	by the legislature to be in excess."	
10	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
11	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
12	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and	
13	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal	
14	year 2018-2019 to the department of health to reimburse the	
15	counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui for expenses incurred during	
16	2015 and 2016 related to the services associated with handling	
17	and collecting electronic devices for recycling pursuant to	
18	chapter 339D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.	
19	The	sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
20	of health	for the purposes of this Act.
