H.B. NO. 19714

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homelessness is a 2 critical issue in the State. Furthermore, the increasing number 3 of illegal homeless camps are a threat to public health and 4 safety. The legislature further finds that innovative solutions 5 are needed to provide alternative living options for homeless 6 individuals. "Work camping", already a popular employment trend 7 among private campgrounds across the nation, provides workers 8 with a campsite in exchange for their services maintaining park 9 grounds and programs.

10 Accordingly, this Act requires the department of land and 11 natural resources to establish a "stay for work" program for the 12 purpose of providing a new alternative to illegal homeless 13 encampments. The program shall provide homeless individuals and 14 families with legal campsites at state parks in exchange for 15 their volunteer services maintaining park grounds.



1	SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part XVII to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§346- Park campsite program. (a) The department of
5	land and natural resources shall implement a program to provide
6	homeless individuals and families with legal campsites on park
7	grounds in exchange for the adult individuals' volunteer
8	services maintaining park grounds.
9	(b) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
10	91 to effectuate the purposes of this section provided that the
11	program meets the following requirements:
12	(1) Volunteers shall not be required to work more than
13	twenty-five hours per week; and
14	(2) Campsites provided must be suitable for a tent or
15	other temporary dwelling, have access to public bathrooms
16	and showers, and have a place suitable to build a fire for
17	cooking.
18	(c) Compliance with program rules shall afford program
19	participants the continued right to occupy the provided
20	campsite."
21	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
