SECTION 1. Section 604-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The district courts shall try and determine all 4 actions without a jury, subject to appeal according to law. 5 Whenever a civil matter is triable of right by a jury and trial by jury is demanded in the manner and within the time provided 6 7 by the rules of court, the case shall be transferred to the 8 circuit court. If the demand is made in the complaint and the 9 matter is triable of right by a jury, the action may be 10 commenced in the circuit court if the amount in controversy 11 exceeds [\$5,000." 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

- and upon ratification of a constitutional amendment to increase 2
- the threshold value in controversy requirement for jury trials 3
