15	unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.			
16	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective			
17	capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the			
18	designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.			
19	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on J	ul	y 1, 2017.
