A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to:
3	(1) Repeal and abolish various non-general funds, pursuant
4	to the recommendations made by the auditor in
5	auditor's report nos. 16-09, 16-10, and 16-11; and
6	(2) Transfer the unencumbered balances as recommended by
7	the auditor.
8	PART II
9	SECTION 2. The emergency appropriation - office of the
10	governor trust fund administratively established in 2011 is
11	abolished, and any remaining unencumbered balances shall be
12	transferred to the general fund.
13	PART III
14	SECTION 3. The healthcare transformation coordinator grant
15	trust fund administratively established in 2012 by the office of
16	the governor is abolished, and any remaining unencumbered



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1	balances shall be transferred to the Hawaii community
2	foundation.
3	PART IV
4	SECTION 4. The planning and research special fund
5	administratively established by the office of Hawaiian affairs
6	is abolished, and any remaining unencumbered balances shall be
7	transferred to the office of Hawaiian affairs main trust
8	account.
9	PART V
10	SECTION 5. The purpose of this part is to repeal the
11	education research and development revolving fund.
12	The legislature finds that the fund does not meet the self-
13	sustaining criteria for a revolving fund and should be repealed.
14	SECTION 6. Section 302A-305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15	repealed.
16	[" [§302A-305] Education research and development revolving
17	fund. (a) There is established, within the department of
18	education, an education research and development revolving fund
19	into which shall be deposited all revenues from the commercial
20	exploitation of products and services developed by the
21	department. The fund shall be used to support research and



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1	development of innovative curriculum, instructional-aids,
2	related technologies, and the related administrative costs of
3	seeking and maintaining such commercialization. Appropriations
4	or authorizations from the fund-shall be expended by the
5	superintendent.
6	(b) The department shall provide an annual report to the
7	governor and the legislature describing all transactions and
8	activities involved in the administration of the education
9	research and development revolving fund."]
10	SECTION 7. On July 1, 2017, all unencumbered balances
11	remaining in the education research and development revolving
12	fund repealed by section 6 of this Act shall lapse to the credit
13	of the general fund.
14	PART VI
15	SECTION 8. The families for resources and early access to
16	learning program special fund administratively established by
17	the department of education is abolished, and any remaining
18	unencumbered balances shall be transferred to the emergency and
19	budget reserve fund established pursuant to section 328L-3,
20	Hawaii Revised Statutes.

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1	PART VII
2	SECTION 9. The school community services (adult education)
3	trust fund administratively established in 2011 by the
4	department of education is abolished, and any remaining
5	unencumbered balances shall be transferred to the general fund.
6	PART VIII
7	SECTION 10. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken.
9	SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
