A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal and
3	abolish various non-general funds, pursuant to the
4	recommendations made by the auditor in auditor's report nos. 16-
5	09, 16-10, and 16-11, and to transfer the unencumbered balances
6	as recommended by the auditor.
7	PART II
8	SECTION 2. The emergency appropriation - office of the
9	governor trust fund administratively established in 2011 is
10	abolished, and any remaining unencumbered balances shall be
11	transferred to the general fund.
12	PART III
13	SECTION 3. The healthcare transformation coordinator grant
14	trust fund administratively established in 2012 by the office of
15	the governor is abolished, and any remaining unencumbered
16	balances shall be transferred to the Hawaii community
17	foundation.

1	PART IV
2	SECTION 4. The planning and research special fund
3	administratively established by the office of Hawaiian affairs
4	is abolished, and any remaining unencumbered balances shall be
5	transferred to the office of Hawaiian affairs main trust
6	account.
7	PART V
8	SECTION 5. The purpose of this part is to repeal the
9	education research and development revolving fund.
10	The legislature finds that the fund does not meet the self-
11	sustaining criteria for a revolving fund and should be repealed.
12	SECTION 6. Section 302A-305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	repealed.
14	[" [§302A-305] Education research and development revolving
15	fund. (a) There is established, within the department of
16	education, an education research and development revolving fund
17	into which shall be deposited all revenues from the commercial
18	exploitation of products and services developed by the
19	department. The fund shall be used to support research and
20	development of innovative curriculum, instructional aids,
21	related technologies, and the related administrative costs of

- 2 or authorizations from the fund shall be expended by the
- 3 superintendent.
- 4 (b) The department shall provide an annual report to the

- 8 SECTION 7. On July 1, 2017, all unencumbered balances
- 9 remaining in the education research and development revolving
- 10 fund repealed by section 6 of this Act shall lapse to the credit
- 11 of the general fund.

- 13 SECTION 8. The families for resources and early access to
- 14 learning program special fund administratively established by
- 15 the department of education is abolished, and any remaining
- 16 unencumbered balances shall be transferred to the emergency and
- 17 budget reserve fund established pursuant to section 328L-3,
- 18 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

- 20 SECTION 9. The school community services (adult education)
- 21 trust fund administratively established in 2011 by the

- 2 unencumbered balances shall be transferred to the general fund.

- 4 SECTION 10. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken.
- 6 SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
