

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARIJUANA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The purpose of this Act is to repeal criminal penalties for marijuana possession, but retain penalties for 2 3 marijuana cultivation and distribution. SECTION 2. 10	pounds or more;
11	(b) (a) Distributes marijuana having an aggregate weight
12	of one pound or more;
13	(c) Possesses, cultivates, or has under the person's
14	control] (b) Cultivates fifty or more marijuana
15	plants;
16	$[\frac{d}{d}]$ <u>(c)</u> Cultivates on land owned by another person,
17	including land owned by the government or other legal
18	entity, any marijuana plant, unless the person has the
19	express permission from the owner of the land to
20	cultivate the marijuana or the person has a legal or

2	person has a legal right to occupy the land; or
3	$[\frac{(e)}{(e)}]$ (d) Sells or barters any marijuana or any Schedule V
4	substance in any amount to a minor."
5	SECTION 10. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 11. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
