A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 249-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended as follows:
3	1. By amending the definition of "bicycle" to read:
4	""Bicycle" means [every device] <u>:</u>
5	(1) A device propelled solely by human power upon which
6	any person may ride, having two tandem wheels sixteen
7	inches in diameter or greater, and including any
8	device generally recognized as a bicycle though
9	equipped with two front or two rear wheels[+]; or
10	(2) A low-speed electric bicycle, as defined under title
11	15 United States Code section 2085."
12	2. By amending the definition of "moped" to read:
13	""Moped" means a device upon which a person may ride which
14	has two or three wheels in contact with the ground, a motor
15	having a maximum power output capability measured at the motor
16	output shaft, in accordance with the Society of Automotive
17	Engineers standards, of two horsepower (one thousand four



1 hundred ninety-two watts) or less and, if it is a combustion 2 engine, a maximum piston or rotor displacement of 3.05 cubic 3 inches (fifty cubic centimeters) and which will propel the 4 device, unassisted, on a level surface at a maximum speed no 5 greater than thirty miles per hour; and a direct or automatic 6 power drive system which requires no clutch or gear shift 7 operation by the moped driver after the drive system is engaged with the power unit [-], but excludes low-speed electric 8 9 bicycles." 10 3. By amending the definition of "motor vehicle" to read:

Il ""Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which is selfpropelled and every vehicle which is propelled by electric power
but which is not operated upon rails, but excludes mopeds [-] and
low-speed electric bicycles."

4. By amending the definition of "vehicle" to read:
""Vehicle" means every device in, upon, or by which any
person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a
highway, but excludes devices moved by human power or devices
used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks [and],
mopeds [-], and low-speed electric bicycles."

Section 291C-148, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 10 "(b) Unless otherwise prohibited, a bicycle may be driven 11 at a speed of ten miles per hour or less on a sidewalk or 12 sidewalk area; provided that the driver of the bicycle shall 13 yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian and that bicycle riding shall be prohibited on sidewalks in business districts [-]; 14 15 provided further that low-speed electric bicycle riding shall be 16 prohibited on all sidewalks." SECTION 5. Section 293-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 18 amended to read as follows: 19 "[+] §293-1[+] Defacing serial numbers, etc., of bicycles. It shall be unlawful for any person to wilfully deface, destroy, 20 or alter the serial number, a component part number, or 21

identification mark of any bicycle, <u>including a low-speed</u>
 <u>electric bicycle as defined under title 15 United States Code</u>
 <u>section 2085</u>, so placed or stamped on any bicycle by the
 manufacturer for the purpose of identifying the bicycle or its
 component parts.

6 This section does not prohibit the restoration by an owner 7 of an original mark or number, when the restoration is authorized in writing by the county treasurer or director of 8 9 finance, nor prevent any manufacturer from placing in the 10 ordinary course of business, numbers or marks upon new bicycles 11 or new parts thereof. Violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor and shall result in a fine of not more than \$500." 12 13 SECTION 6. Section 293-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended to read as follows:

15 "[+]§293-2[+] Bicycle dealers, records required. All
16 persons selling new bicycles [to others], including a low-speed
17 electric bicycle as defined under title 15 United States Code
18 section 2085, as a business shall keep a record for four years
19 after the sale of a bicycle of the name of the purchaser, and
20 the serial number, description, and make of the bicycle sold to

3 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.

Report Title: Low-speed Electric Bicycles; Bicycles

Description:

Clarifies the definition of "bicycles" for purposes of county vehicular taxes, highway safety laws, statewide traffic code, and bicycle laws by adding "low-speed electric bicycles" and defining low-speed electric bicycles. Excludes low-speed electric bicycles from the definitions of "moped", "motor vehicle", and "vehicle". Prohibits low-speed electric bicycle riding on all sidewalks.
