A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATURE, THE AUDITOR, THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, THE OMBUDSMAN, AND THE ETHICS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$9,669,111 or so much
 thereof as may be necessary to the senate for the following
 expenses:

13 SECTION 3. Payment of expenses of the senate during the 14 interim between the 2017 and 2018 regular sessions shall be made 15 only with the approval of the president of the senate, and 16 payment of expenses of the house of representatives during the 17 interim between the 2017 and 2018 regular sessions shall be made 18 only with the approval of the speaker of the house of 19 representatives.

20 SECTION 4. Before January 17, 2018, the senate and the
21 house of representatives shall each have their accounts audited,

1 and a full report of the respective audits shall be presented to 2 the senate and house of representatives convening on January 17, 3 2018. 4 SECTION 5. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the 5 expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad 6 on official business of the legislature shall be \$145 a day as 7 authorized by the president of the senate and speaker of the 8 house of representatives. 9 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,151,649 or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor for the 12 following expenses: 13 (1) The sum of \$3,001,649 for defraying the expenses of 14 the office of the auditor during fiscal year 2017-2018; and 15 16 The sum of \$150,000 during fiscal year 2017-2018 for: (2) 17 (A) Performing special studies; 18 Improving capabilities for planning, programming, (B) 19 and budgeting; 20 (C) Fulfilling other special requests made of the 21 auditor by the legislature or jointly by the

13	fiscal year 2017-2018 to be deposited into the audit revolving				
14	fund established pursuant to section 23-3.6, Hawaii Revised				
15	Statutes.				
16	SECTION 8	. There is appropriated out of the audit			
17	revolving fund the sum of \$6,300,000 or so much thereof as may				
18	be necessary to the office of the auditor during fiscal year				
19	2017-2018 for the office to conduct or complete its audit				
20	functions as provided by law.

The sum appropriated shall be expended by the auditor.



1 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,676,187 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary to the legislative reference bureau 4 for defraying the expenses of the legislative reference bureau during fiscal year 2017-2018, including equipment relating to 5 6 computer systems programming and operations. 7 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by 8 the legislative reference bureau. 9 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,316,799 or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the ombudsman for 12 defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year 2017-13 2018. 14 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by 15 the ombudsman. 16 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out the of general 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,112,093 or so much 18 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the state ethics commission for defraying the expenses of the office during 19 20 fiscal year 2017-2018.



1 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by 2 the state ethics commission. 3 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums or so much 5 thereof as may be necessary to be expended for the purpose of 6 accrued vacation payments and vacation transfer payments for any 7 employee leaving the employ of the senate, house of 8 representatives, office of the auditor, legislative reference 9 bureau, office of the ombudsman, and state ethics commission: 10 Expending Agency Amount 11 Senate \$150,000 12 House of Representatives \$224,524 13 Office of the Auditor \$68,106 14 Legislative Reference Bureau \$26,810 15 Office of the Ombudsman \$14,035 16 State Ethics Commission \$16,553 17 provided that the appropriate expending agency shall first make 18 payments from the vacation payout allocation before expending 19 funds from turnover and vacancy amounts; and provided further 20 that any unexpended funds shall lapse to the general fund on 21 June 30, 2018.

SECTION 13. Except for moneys in the audit revolving fund,
 as of the close of business on June 30, 2018, the unexpended or
 unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act shall
 lapse into the general fund.

5 SECTION 14. Each section of this Act is declared to be6 severable from the remainder of this Act.

7 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
