RELATING TO THE FAILURE TO FILE A REPORT WITH THE CAMPAIGN SPENDING COMMISSION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-340, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows: 3 The commission shall publish on its website the names 4 of all candidate and noncandidate committees that have failed 5 to: 6 (1) File a report; or 7 (2) Correct a report within [the time allowed by] two 8 weeks from the notice to correct provided by the 9 commission." 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Failure to File a Report or Corrected Report; Publishing Names of Violators
