BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-340, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows: 3 The commission shall publish on its website the names of all candidate and noncandidate committees that have failed 4 5 to: 6 (1) File a report; or 7 (2) Correct a report within [the time allowed by] two 8 weeks from the notice to correct provided by the 9 commission." SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 10 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
