
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CLASS C FELONIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 166, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014, section
2 1, is amended by amending subsection (c) of section 11-15.2,
3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, to read as follows:

4 "(c) The registration clerk shall process applications for
5 any person not registered to vote who submits a signed affidavit
6 in accordance with section 11-15, which shall include a sworn
7 affirmation:

8 (1) Of the person's qualification to vote;

9 (2) Acknowledging that the person has not voted and will
10 not vote at any other polling place for that election
11 and has not cast and will not cast any absentee ballot
12 pursuant to chapter 15 for that election; and

13 (3) Acknowledging that providing false information [~~may~~
14 ~~result in~~] is a class C felony [~~, punishable by a fine~~
15 ~~not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding~~
16 ~~five years, or both]~~."



1 SECTION 2. Section 15-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:

3 "(e) The registration clerk shall process applications for
4 any person not registered to vote who submits a signed affidavit
5 in accordance with section 11-15, which shall include a sworn
6 affirmation:

7 (1) Of the person's qualification to vote;

8 (2) Acknowledging that the person has not voted and will
9 not vote at any other polling place for that election
10 and has not cast and will not cast any absentee ballot
11 pursuant to chapter 15 for that election; and

12 (3) Acknowledging that providing false information [~~may~~
13 ~~result in~~] is a class C felony [~~, punishable by a fine~~
14 ~~not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding~~
15 ~~five years, or both]."~~

16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050;
19 provided that section 1 shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
