A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homelessness 2 continues to be one of the State's most significant and
- 3 challenging social problems. Homeless people face many
- 4 different issues, including mental illness, substance abuse,
- 5 loss of employment and income, and a lack of affordable housing.
- 6 Appropriate funding for programs tailored to address these
- 7 issues is essential.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to require the Hawaii housing
- 9 finance and development corporation to conduct a survey to
- 10 identify and inventory state-owned and state-managed housing
- 11 units that could provide affordable rental housing for the
- 12 State's homeless. This Act also requires the department of
- 13 human services to convene a homeless summit to develop
- 14 strategies to address homelessness.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii housing finance and development
- 16 corporation shall conduct a survey to identify and inventory
- 17 state-owned and state-managed housing units statewide that are

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- 1 vacant and could be used as affordable rental housing under
- 2 chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, including housing units
- 3 that could be used as affordable rental housing if renovated or
- 4 restored.
- 5 (b) The Hawaii housing finance and development corporation
- 6 shall report to the governor and the legislature, no later than
- 7 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- 8 2018, on the results of the survey conducted under this section,
- 9 including providing an inventory list that identifies each
- 10 vacant unit by legal owner, street location, and tax map key
- 11 number.
- 12 SECTION 3. The department of human services shall convene
- 13 a homeless summit to be held before December 1, 2017. The
- 14 purpose of the summit shall be to gather experts from around the
- 15 world to share and develop strategies to address homelessness.
- 16 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for the
- 19 purpose of convening a homeless summit.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 21 human services for the purposes of section 3 of this Act.



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SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
