A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 147, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 "PART . ORGANIC AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS
- 5 §147- Definitions. As used in this part:
- 6 "Agricultural product" means all agricultural,
- 7 horticultural, and vegetable produce of the soil; poultry,
- 8 poultry products, livestock, and livestock products; processed
- 9 products; and wild crops.
- 10 "Board" means the board of agriculture.
- 11 "National Organic Program" means the federal National
- 12 Organic Program administered by the United States Department of
- 13 Agriculture.
- "Processed product" means a product that has been handled
- 15 and packaged; or combined, processed, and packaged.
- 16 §147- Organic agricultural product certification,
- 17 labeling, and advertising. (a) Beginning January 1, 2018, no

- 1 agricultural product that is sold in the State shall be labeled,
- 2 advertised, or otherwise represented to be organic unless the
- 3 farm or handling facility that produced or processed the product
- 4 has been certified by a qualified certifying agent pursuant to
- 5 the National Organic Program.
- 6 (b) Nothing in this part shall be construed to relieve any
- 7 agricultural product from any other labeling or advertising
- 8 requirement pursuant to federal or state statute, rule, or
- 9 regulation.
- 10 §147- Rules; violations; penalties. (a) The board
- 11 shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter 91, necessary for the
- 12 purposes of this part.
- (b) A violation of this part, or any rule adopted pursuant
- 14 to this part, shall be punishable by a fine of not more than
- 15 \$1,000 for each violation."
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 18 begun before its effective date.
- 19 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 20 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
- 21 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or

- applications of the Act that can be given effect without the 1
- invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions 2
- 3 of this Act are severable.

This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 4 SECTION 4.
