A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that rising prison
populations and shrinking correctional budgets have made
reducing costs important for correctional facilities.

The legislature further finds that prison farm programs can reduce correctional costs by producing food in-house, increase food self-sufficiency for correctional facilities, and address the correctional issues of underused labor power and inmates in need of programs and rehabilitation.

9 The legislature further finds that inmates working on 10 prison farm programs tend to be less aggressive, less prone to 11 recidivism, and healthier, and tend to consume a higher-quality 12 diet. Farm inmates are also exposed to a functioning workplace 13 and gain benefits such as employability, time management and 14 responsibility skills, access to nature, individual and team 15 building skills, and conflict resolution.

16 Prison farm programs also offer a unique environment where17 inmates learn a variety of technical skills and trades. Farm



1 inmates also learn the practice of horticulture, including 2 caring for and identifying plants, managing and controlling 3 pests, applying planting and harvesting techniques, and 4 performing watering and weeding. Farm inmates also have the 5 opportunity to learn to drive and operate a tractor and learn to 6 repair farm machinery. 7 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for: A full-time agricultural management position and 8 (1)9 equipment for Kulani correctional facility agriculture 10 operations; and 11 (2) A full-time agricultural management position and 12 equipment for Waiawa correctional facility agriculture 13 operations. 14 There is appropriated out of the general SECTION 2. 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and 17 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 18 year 2018-2019 for the establishment of one full-time equivalent 19 (1.00 FTE) agricultural management position in the department of 20 public safety to manage agricultural operations at Kulani 21 correctional facility.

There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for 11 Waiawa correctional facility agriculture operations; provided 12 that the appropriation shall be designated as follows: 13 for four egg production-chicken tractors; (1)\$ 14 (2) \$ for one water tank; 15 for five greenhouses; (3) \$ 16 (4)\$ for one processing container; 17 (5) \$ for one Kubota tractor; 18 for one rotary cutter; (6) \$ 19 (7) for one spray tank; \$ 20 (8) \$ for a tandem disc harrow; and 21 for fencing materials.
