## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVANCE HEALTH-CARE DIRECTIVES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 327E-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) An individual acting as agent, guardian, or surrogate
- 4 under this chapter shall not be subject to civil or criminal
- 5 liability or to discipline for unprofessional conduct for
- 6 health-care decisions made in good faith [-], unless the
- 7 complainant shows by clear and convincing evidence that the
- 8 health-care decision of the individual was contrary to the
- 9 intent of the patient."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
