### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, according to 2010
- 2 census data, Hawaii island has the highest per capita incidence
- 3 of impaired driving cases of all the counties in the State.
- 4 Hawaii island accounts for 13.6 per cent of the population of
- 5 the State, but accounts for twenty-five per cent of the State's
- 6 impaired driving cases.
- 7 On Oahu, a driving while impaired (DWI) court started in
- 8 2013, and has proven effective in providing treatment and
- 9 reducing recidivism rates of the individuals who chose to
- 10 participate. DWI court programs are post-conviction programs
- 11 that utilize intensive supervision and long-term treatment
- 12 methods to change the behavior of repeat impaired driving
- 13 offenders. The DWI court programs employ the strategies of
- 14 close supervision, frequent alcohol and other drug testing, and
- 15 ongoing judicial interaction to integrate treatment services
- 16 into the justice system.
