A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The auditor shall conduct a performance audit
- 2 of the land lease and revocable permit programs administered by
- 3 the land division of the department of land and natural
- 4 resources. The auditor shall make recommendations to the
- 5 legislature based on the performance audit, as appropriate.
- 6 SECTION 2. The auditor shall submit a report on the
- 7 performance audit, including the auditor's findings,
- 8 recommendations, and proposed legislation, if necessary, to the
- 9 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 10 the regular session of 2019.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
- 14 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 15 2018-2019 to hire two analysts, one senior analyst, and
- 16 consultants, as necessary, to conduct the performance audit of

- 1 the department of land and natural resources pursuant to this
- 2 Act.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the auditor for
- 4 the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
